# Ann meeting with Interim Provost Spain

- Dr. Spain is asking System for funding for the Libraries to help with the cost of inflation of journal prices.
- His request will not fully cover the \$1.8 million gap, but will be helpful in covering about half of the need.
  - We hope he will be able to secure \$1 million for University Libraries with the expectation that we do not break Elsevier.

# Budget update

- Last week the Chancellor announced that the University Libraries will remain harmless from the 10%, 12.5% or 15% cuts as part of the University's commitment to research being central to its mission.
- There will be a Campus Budget Meeting on May 24. We hope to know more about the System's response to Dr. Spain's funding request for University Libraries at that time.

# Ground level space

- Center for Teaching for Learning has asked for the North West portion of the ground level.
  - The University has been holding interviews for the new Director of the Center for Teaching for Learning.
  - o Ann's old office in Technical Services will house this new director.
  - This person would potentially be hired by August.
  - The Center would like one classroom space.
- The Art museum is interested in some of the ground level space and is coming to look at the space in the near future.
- Archives will move to the North East portion of the ground level.
- Disabilities testing will probably be in the old art gallery space.

# Events Team report

- Duties have shifted from helping with library events to more facilitating outside events.
- Discussion opened for Ellis library space guidelines to be revised.
- The Libraries' commitment to accommodating more outside groups was reiterated as a positive move for the Libraries to remain relevant and central to campus.

Action: Ann will meet with Events Team to draft new guidelines.

- Jeannette proposed an Instruction Committee charge, chaired by Joe Askins.
  - Specific edit suggestions were made from LMT members.
  - o It was proposed that Instruction Committee be a standing committee.
