- Sorting items by barcode was broken in Folio and has now been fixed.
- Records that are showing up in the wrong place has been an issue and there needs to be an annual check to make sure this remains correct and up to date.
- "Locate" is an alternative database to MOBIUS that may be a more reliable resource than EDS
  - Main issue is that Locate is un-scoped and will show all information without location filter
- MOBIUS migration is still on schedule.
