


E-Reserve Items (ERes)

It is possible to link to an ERes course, but not to an article in ERes. You will need to supply the password to the students if the ERes course is passworded.

1. From the MU Libraries Gateway, select Search E-Reserves.



2. Look up the desired course.



3. Do a right mouse click on the title of the desired course. Select "Copy Shortcut" or "Copy Link Location."


