

PREFACE

by David J. Marcou

This book presents a sampling of photos that are stored in public archives and made by my son (Matthew) and me. We've included old-reliable images we added to archives early on, eventually including the Smithsonian and the British National Portrait Gallery, plus newer works. All these photos are in various archives, though most aren't archive-attributed here, due to the multiple locations of many of our images. Comprising photos of the famous and everyday, 'A Modest Archival Photobook' is not irrelevant to our times; it is focused on our times — with, we hope, timeless insights.

I lived/worked as a journalist in London (1981) and Seoul (1984-87). My son has been abroad twice, when he was a toddler, visiting his mother's homeland (South Korea) with her. In 2000, Matt and I visited Washington, D.C., and published our photo-essay-book, 'Vital Washington.' In 2006, Matt visited there on his own, staying with his Uncle Tom and Aunt Joy. We've been many places in America; and I'd graduated from UW-Madison, UI-Iowa City, and UM-Columbia, early on. Matt intends to enter the Army soon, after attending for three years the UM-Minneapolis.

My son has collaborated with me on many books, and he typed the 100,000-word manuscript for the first volume of the word-photo group-book 'Spirit of America'. I've authored 14 personal books (many with Matt's involvement), and directed/edited 13 group-books. And in 2006, the group I direct (the American Writers and Photographers Alliance) earned a Governor's Commendation for 'Spirit of the World.'

Reinhart Ethics in Leadership Institute; our family; friends; teachers; students; peers; group-book contributors; and production teams, especially our advisors David A. and Rose C. 


































