













In addition to photographing people in informal photo portraits, I also like to photograph them moving physically, showing speed. Often, I can capture obvious signs of their motion; other times, I show their bodies suggestive of movement without showing a blur. In either case, I hope to show human life as it's actually lived.

“Traditional photographers have a hard time interpreting a free-flowing journalistic style. I think it's important to have a modern feel for portraits and a journalist's eye for the grab shot.”



























