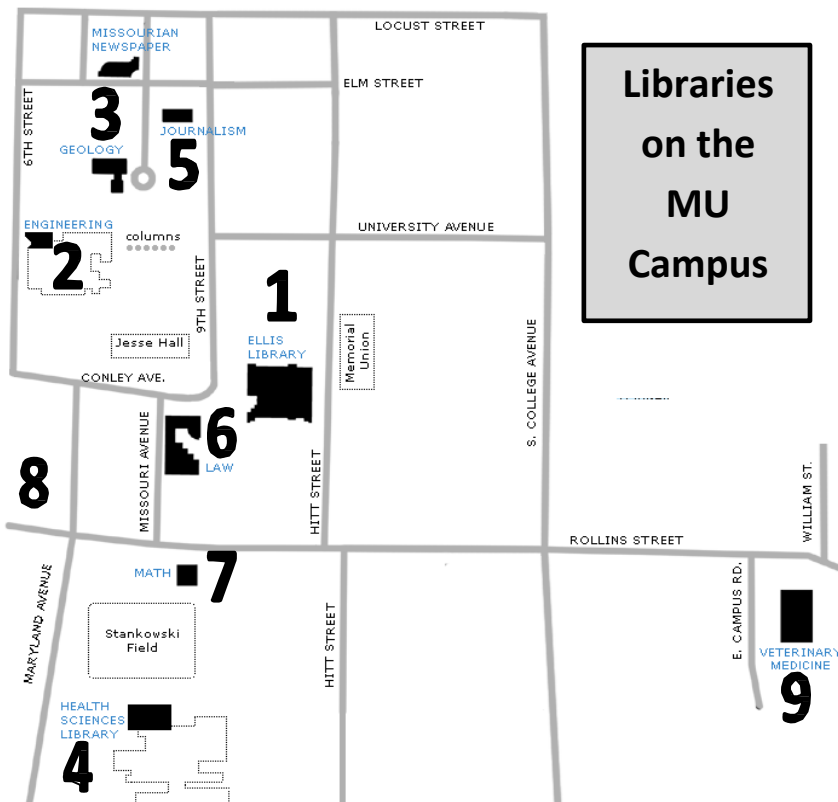


A Self-Guided Tour of Ellis Library

MU Libraries consists of Ellis Library (the main library), six specialized branch Libraries, two off-site storage facilities, and the University Archives. The MU Law Library, the State Historical Society, and the Western Manuscripts Collection are also located on MU campus.

Ellis Library is located on Lowry Mall, the pedestrian zone between Hitt and Conley Streets. Visitor parking (numbered spaces) is available on levels 3, 6, and 7 of Turner Avenue Garage at the corner of 6th and Conley Streets. Wireless internet access is available to MU students, faculty, staff throughout Ellis Library. The building is open to the public.
