- Update on IATS's "support model" for Cascade Server during the pilot:
 - The following support structure is currently in place for Cascade Server
 - **PHP** – PHP is installed and configured in the Priority Web Environment (PWE).
 - **ASP** – ASP may be supported in the future if we add Windows servers into the PWE server farm. The PWE is currently housed on Linux-servers, and if Windows-based servers are added the addition would not occur during the pilot.
 - **ColdFusion** – ColdFusion will not be supported on the PWE. This is in accordance with IATS' direction away from ColdFusion as a development platform.
 - additionally:
 - IATS will only support cascade.missouri.edu and the PWE (Primary Web Environment). This means that IATS will only support the transportation of data inside Cascade and to the PWE, not to external sources (other servers and other web environments). IATS will only support what assets it maintains, otherwise IATS would have to support other assets which it has no responsibility over.
- Kevin Bailey at IATS has been contacted regarding the above support model, specifically as it relates to allowing the MU Libraries pilot to make use of its own servers (as destination servers) in order to continue to use ASP and ColdFusion.
- Michael demonstrated a bit of what he has set up and created in Cascade Server to date.
- Additional information regarding where Cascade Server is outputting the html files is needed. [Anselm will check on this]
- The two subgroups will continue to work on pages for the pilot.
