Library Technology Services (LTS) is the computer support department for the Libraries. The department maintains the public and staff machines at Ellis and at the Math, Engineering & Geology libraries and maintains and runs the server that hosts the MU Libraries web sites. We support 400 computers, 50 librarians, 100 support staff and 150 work study and hourly students. **Information & Access Technology Services** (IAT Services) is the computer support department for the University of Missouri – Columbia. They offer a wide variety of services, including some software training.

- 3. You may not add any PIRATED software to your computer.
- 4. You may not add another computer to the Libraries network without prior approval from LTS.
- 5. You may not take Libraries equipment or software home. There may be instances where portable equipment can be used at home for work related instances. (Staff may purchase software & hardware for personal use at a discount from Computer Spectrum, in Brady Commons.)
- 6. LTS **may** remove any software from your computer that is causing problems to your machine or the network.
- 7. All hardware and software purchases go through LTS. Contact 884-6404 if you have a need.
