Staff Lounge Water Filter

- The water filter in the Ellis staff lounge was removed in February. (Tammy sent an email to MULIBSTAFF on 2-18-13 regarding this.)
- One possibility is not having a water filter.
 - Jack had shared earlier via email that MU water is safe to drink: http://www.cf.missouri.edu/energy/em_pp/ccr.pdf

- o However, filtered water keeps the coffee machine easier to clean.
- Another possibility is having a Britta type water pitcher.
 - Unused filters from the old system can be returned or sold.
 - Pitchers are simple to use, easy to tell when the filter needs replacing, make clear which water is filtered and which water is unfiltered, and can be made nondesirable to steal through stickers or markings.
 - o Filters for the pitchers (Britta or the more general brand Pur) are relatively inexpensive, and there is a low initial cost investment for MULSA to try it out.
- There was general consensus on trying a Brita type water pitcher.
 - Ruthe will look into getting an aerator on the sink and will look into buying a
 pitcher.
- Discussion continued via email.

Celebration of Service

In 2012: We spent \$840 for celebration of service last year with \$590 going to Jack's . Admin paid the performer (Guitar). We paid \$75 for Allen's flowers, \$21 for drinks, and \$71 for dry flowers and other cute items for the tables. I would think we can use those dry flowers again? Last year was the first year we gave people the option not to have flowers for their years of service.

I think Admin paid for everything at the 2008 celebration of service. My spreadsheet shows we had no expenses in 2008.
