## STAFF ROOM REPORT     1999/2000

This was a fairly eventful year. The term began with Kate Rubbleke and me as the elected Loungettes. A month and ½ into it Kate resigned. The duties of cleaning, recycling and buying supplies have been my job since then. I was very lucky to get Michaelle Dorsey to do the refunding along with her duties on the MUSE. I would also like to thank all those who helped when I took a day off, especially Karen Eubanks.

Our year started out with each office revising their duties. The transition of new officers should be a little easier with this updated information. A Sam's card has been added to the perks of being Staff Room Chair. With the increase in the cost of soda to \$1.00, the recycling, which is used for purchasing supplies, has really gone down. There is also the added expense of water filters. This adds up to \$13 per month, at a total of \$156 per year. By purchasing a quantity of the filters at Sam's, we got a \$30 rebate which went back into the Treasury. Water filters are the best savings at Sam's. There really isn't a significant price difference in napkins and dish soap. The generic brands from any market have a comparable price. The bulk paper towel purchase seems to last almost ½ the year, but we are limited by how much bulk can be stuffed into our supply closet area.

Mid-term our lounge went through some construction. Thanks to Mike Knoll for helping me move ½ the furniture into the old smoker's lounge and then back again. Somewhere around this time our refrigerator started acting up. Various things were tried to mend it---defrosting, vacuuming the coils---but nothing worked. After a lot of discussion, we bought a new one. There have also been a lot of problems with the floors not getting cleaned by the custodians, recycling bottles being taken, the usual exploding food in the microwave and rotten food in the fridge. Our main headache has been the snack and soda machines. And now, direct from Las Vegas, Michaelle Dorsey will give her report on this issue.

## Book Sale Report Troy Gordon & Ruthe Morse

Planning has begun for the 2000 Book Sale. It will be held October 26-28th at the Hearn Center, in the field house, rather than the concourse as it was in 1998. An art contest is about to conclude which will determine the art for the posters and ads for the sale. We are projecting to have a bit smaller sale than the 1998 sale because we have been more selective in the books that were included in it (discarding the 1973 *Book in Print*, rather than putting them in the sale). However, the quality of books included in the sale give us every reason to expect this sale to be our best yet.

We are trying a couple of approaches to resolve some of the continuing problems of past sales. Book dealers (who tend to hoard books at the start of the sale until they sort through them) will be given "restock" boxes, and strongly encouraged to sort their books quickly and fill the restock boxes with books they decide they don't want. This will let us resort and put out those books--hopefully quickly enough that others will have the opportunity to purchase them that night. It will also help to prevent books being randomly put back on tables in the wrong place.

Disposing of the leftover books has also been an ongoing problem. Groups that have agreed to take them in the past have consistently not shown up at the last moment. This year, we will have a recycling dumpster in the Hearn parking lot to put the leftover books in, and will just wheel them in at the conclusion of the sale. To reduce the amount of books, we will encourage schools, prison libraries, etc. to come and take whatever they want Saturday afternoon.

As the sale approaches, sign-up sheets will be circulated asking for people to help with various aspects of the sale. Please be generous with your time and sign up for as much as you can help with! The proceeds of the sale remain as MULSA's major income source and allow us to do the many activities we are involved in. Your support during the sale is essential to allow this to happen!
