Water information on the Ellis library staff lounge

- Aquazero report
 - o Local Company

 - o \$255 for the system and minimal install fee

 - o System takes 2-3 hours to fill up the 2-3 gallon reserve tank

Treasurer's Report: Kathy Peters for Jack Batterson

- Kathy Peters is the acting auditor for this situation
 - August 17, 2013 Jack Batterson accidentally deposited a \$20 personal check and withdrew \$220 from the MULSA account, instead of his personal account
 - He told Rachel Brekhus and Kathy Peters of his error
 - o He returned the \$220 to the MULSA account

 - 6. \$.50 unsold books go on a cart to 4th floor then get sent to Better World Books
 - o Better World Books supplies us boxes

Checking Account – Changing Names on our Checking Account

- Jack contacted the Credit Union about changing the names on the account
 - o Need to take Rachel Brekhus off and add on Kathy Peters and Karla Geerlings
 - The bank requires proof that our organization's by-laws state explicitly the treasurer, president, and vice-president are allowed to open and oversee bank accounts
 - We need to have updated documentation of which officers are authorized to be on the bank account and that documentation needs to state the officers position and name
 - o Currently: Rachel Brekhus and Jack Batterson are check signers on the account
 - o Karla may be grandfathered in
 - o Kathy Peters needs added on
 - Possibility she can't be added on until May 2014
 - Need to resolve the MULSA Constitution issue
 - There may be a more current version of the constitution and bylaws that shows the quorum that others think was passed at one point. Need to search for this file.
 - There is a possibility this version simply didn't get uploaded to the website
 - If the constitution and by-laws have not yet been corrected, we need to make these changes in April 2014

Website

- MULSA is an affinity group with the MU Libraries, but is not MU Libraries
 - o MU provides hosting for our Wordpress site
 - New MU Libraries website, has changed the format and frame of our MULSA page
 - Need to contact LTS
 - Ruth Feldkamp is going to be our LTS Representative
 - o During migration of the site, not all of our content migrated lost information
- New Wordpress Shell
 - Discussed that it was easier to change to a new Wordpress shell and have them migrate the content over to our own personal page

- Easy to link to this new MULSA Wordpress site from the MU Libraries page
- MOSpace and Old MUSE Content
 - o Felicity Dykas asked if we wanted our old MUSE content posted to MOSpace?
 - Could we do this with old MULSA content too?
- MUSE Job Description Change
 - Currently we need someone to just work on older MULSA content and creating a new MULSA Wordpress site
 - Karla Geerlings is looking in to finding someone to fill the position
 - Rachel Brekhus is going to write a rough position description for the current MULSA needs

- New Employee's moving to Ellis Library
 - o Might need to think about another refrigerator and microwave to accommodate
 - Willing to share the staff lounge space with the new employee's in Ellis
 - How many people?
 - Do they need a refrigerator?
 - More paper towels, soap and other supplies
 - Can they abide by the rules of the staff lounge?
 - Send the new employee's a letter giving them the rules
 - Cleaning Rules
 - o Information on if there is a party in the staff lounge
 - They can petition for membership to MULSA
 - If they would like to join in on our parties, need to contribute a social chair and funds
 - They might possibly be using a small seminar room as their break room
 - Need to discuss implications of preservation issues with a separate staff lounge
