    - Change By-laws Article IV, Section 2, these pertain to Member Duties
      - Need to add on ability to change and be on bank accounts for the President. Vice-President and the Treasurer
- Fictitious Name Registration

- o Kathy Peter's recommends using the name registered with our Tax ID #
  - This should be the MU Library Staff Association
  - Kathy recommends we file the registration of fictitious name with Karla Geerlings, Kathy Peter's and Jack Batterson's names on it now and make a change in the future when the Board Membership rolls over
  - Jack will be completing the registration form online
  - Once this is completed, need to change the by-laws
    - By-Laws must be changed by a membership vote in May 2014
      - o Rachel Brekhus states, she can make the changes to By-Laws: Article IV, Section 2.
      - o Our bank is demanding we do this, so please vote "Yes"
  - The bank has us classified as an unincorporated association/club account
- Student Employees
  - Option of an online form for reservations, to ensure we have a head count for the Thanksgiving Dinner
    - Need to provide Jack's with a headcount the week before our meal
- Shelter for the Picnic dates include middle of June to end of June
  - o 1st Choice Gordon Shelter at Stephens Lake

#### Notes:

Last Friday (January 10, 2014), I deposited \$821.08 into our checking. This deposit included \$90 in checks for Adopted Family, two Better World checks \$63.03 (Dated Dec. 20 2013) and \$106.65 (Dated Nov. 26, 2013). This second check from Better World was reported on last month's report). This deposit also included the Ellis Book sale check of \$561.40.

A note to me: The credit union is up until 6 pm on Fridays.

The fund paid a capital gain distribution of 0.0822 per share for a total of \$58.47 that was reinvested to buy 2.816 shares.

The fund also paid a dividend of 0.1398 per share for a total of \$99.83 that was reinvested to buy 4.783 new shares.

In 2013, total dividends from the fund were \$263.55 and that was reinvested to buy 12.803 shares. In 2012, the fund's dividends totaled \$158.06 that was reinvested to buy 8.12 shares. Dividends are paid in March, June (or July), September, and December.

#### Notes:

The answer to a question from the last meeting: The last contribution MULSA made into the mutual fund was on May 21, 2012 when MULSA bought 105.208 shares for \$2,000. The price was \$19.01 per share and MULSA has a 10% gain on those shares. The earlier shares were purchased in 2010 and 2009. MULSA has an 18% (\$643) gain on the shares purchased in 2010 and a 41% (\$662) gain on the shares bought in 2009.

The fund was up 7.74% in 2013 and 8.70% in 2012. The S&P stock index was up 32% in 2013 and about 16% in 2012. The fund is very conservative. It has about 10% in cash and 55% in bonds.
